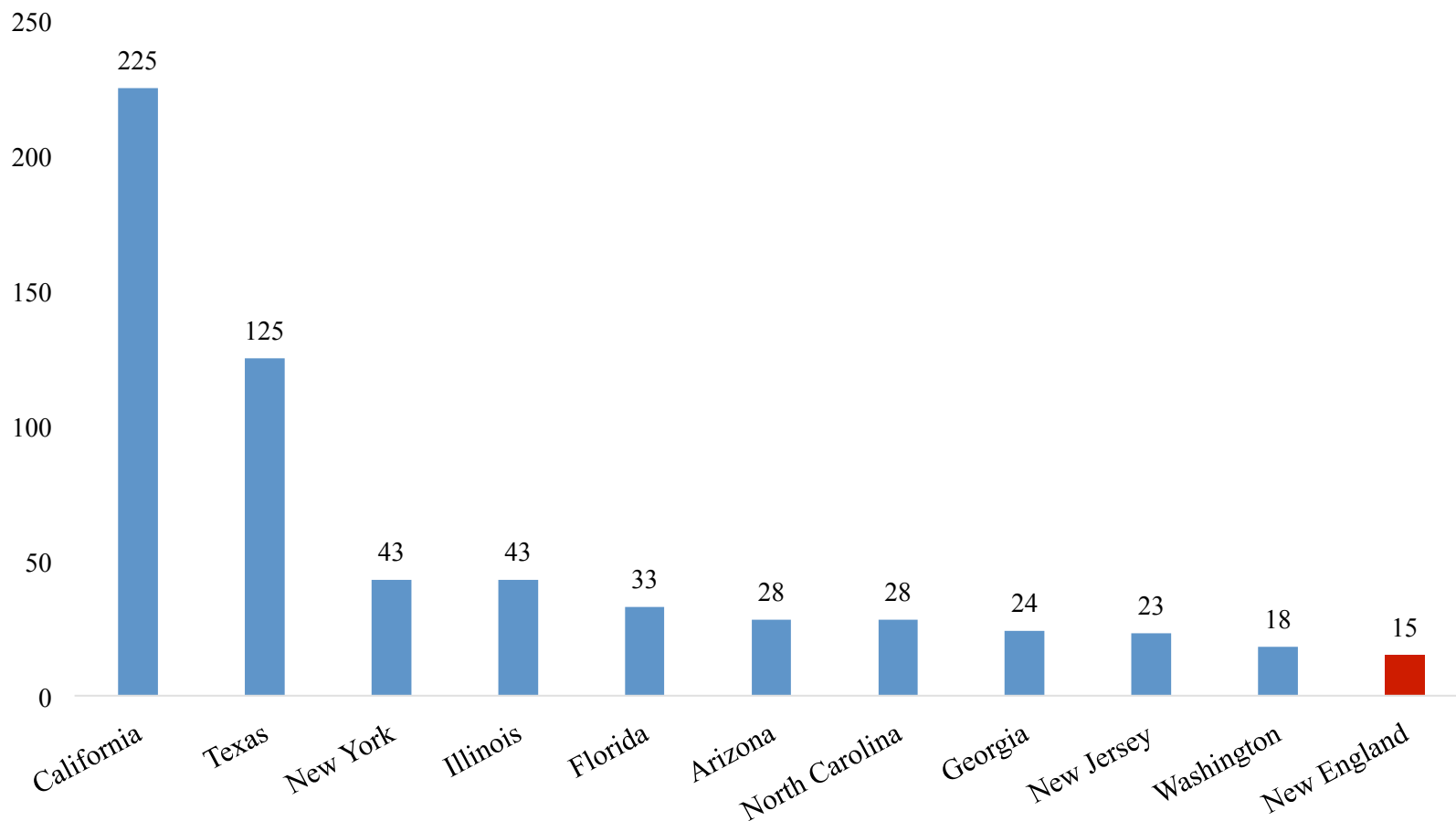

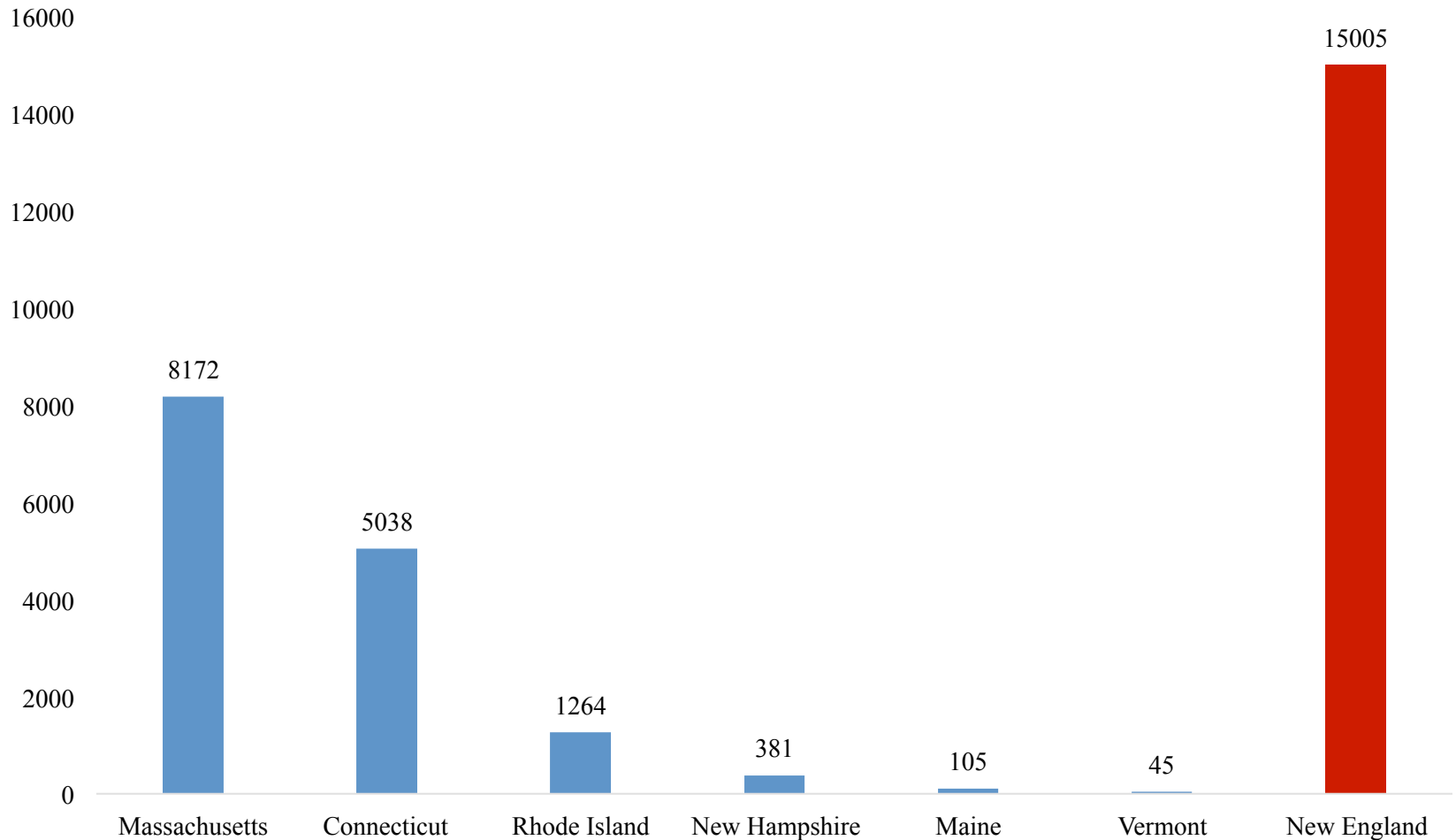

## Number of DACA Initial Applications Approved, 2012-17 (in thousands)



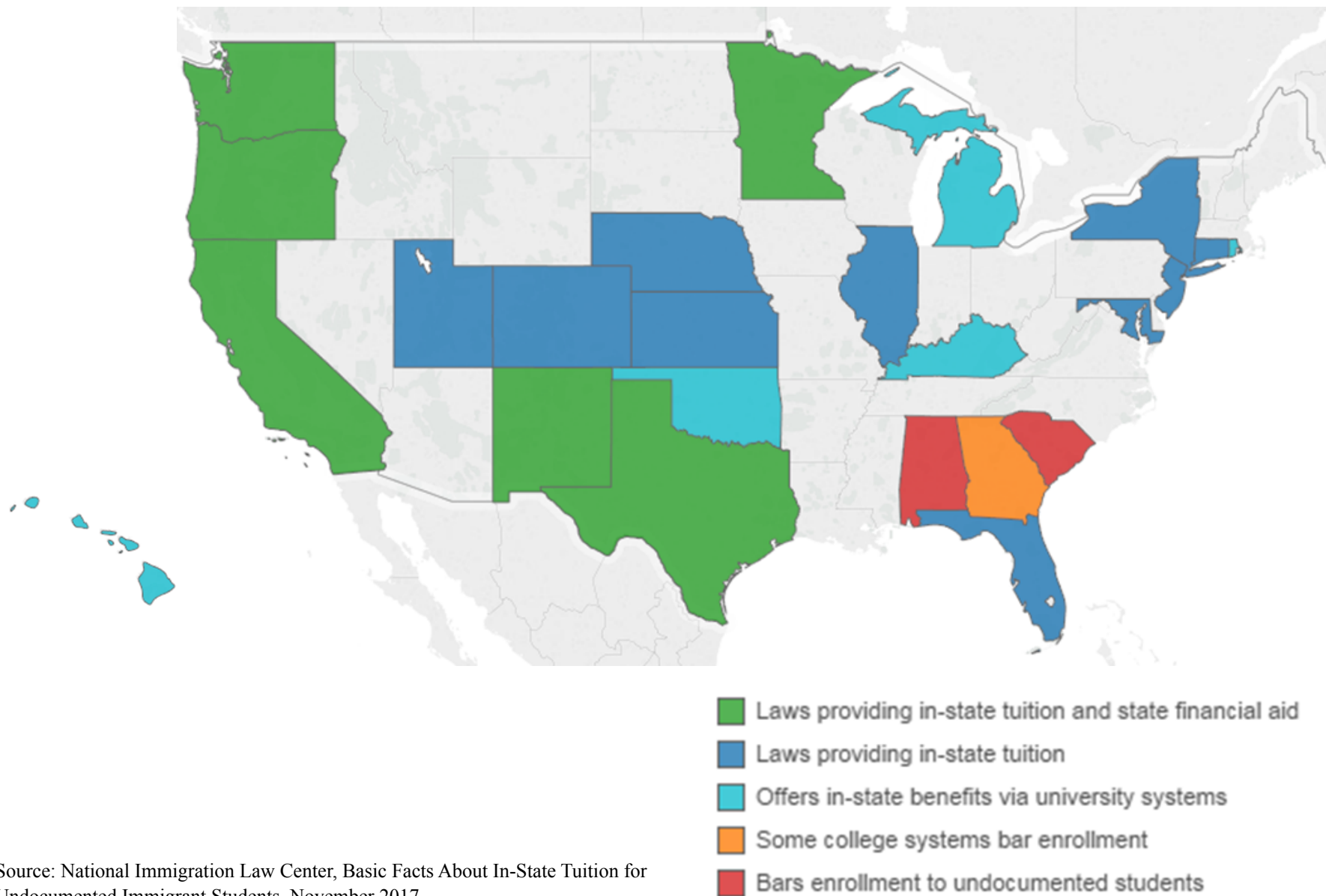

# Number of DACA Initial Applications Approved in New England, 2012-17



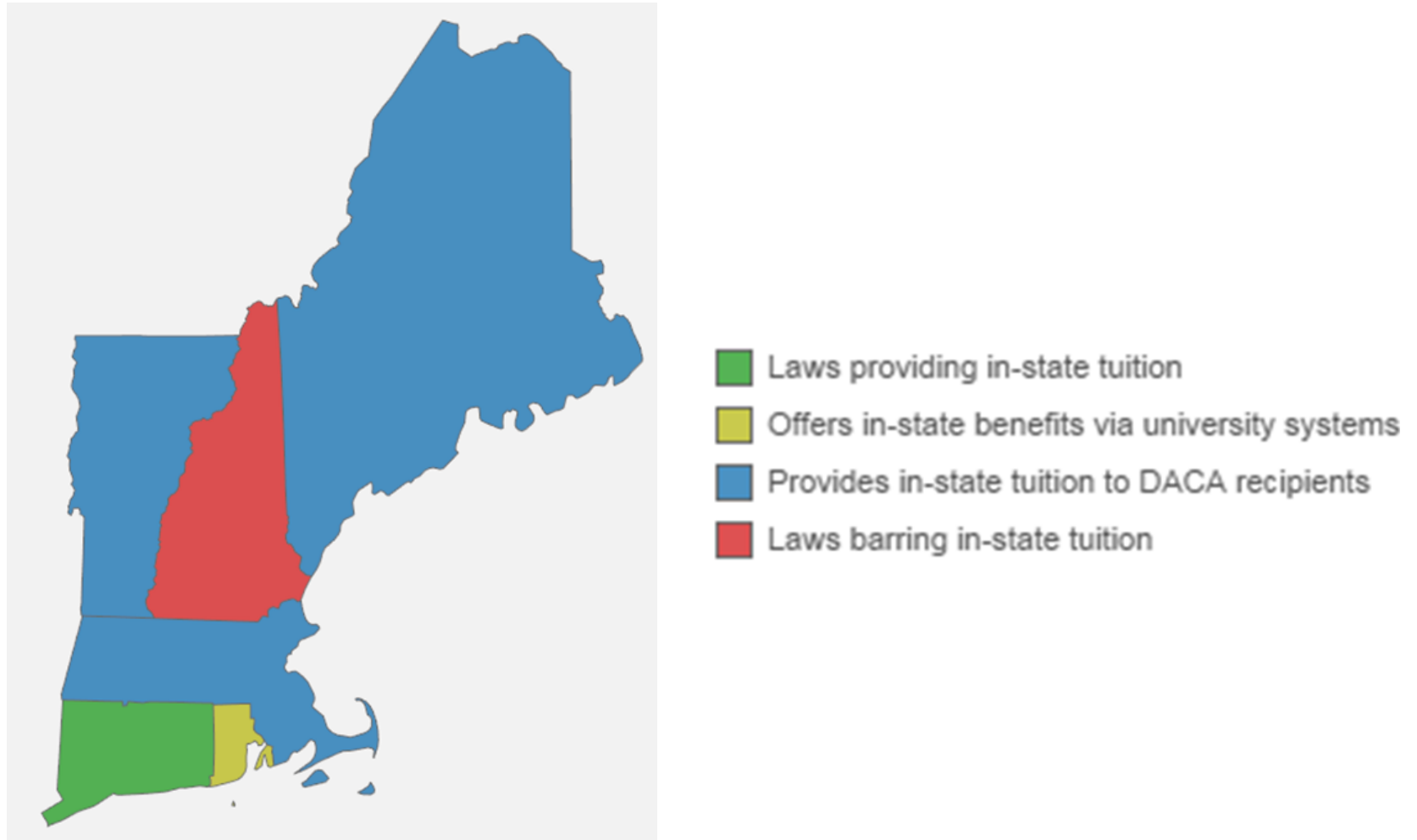

# Tuition and Enrollment Policies for Undocumented Students



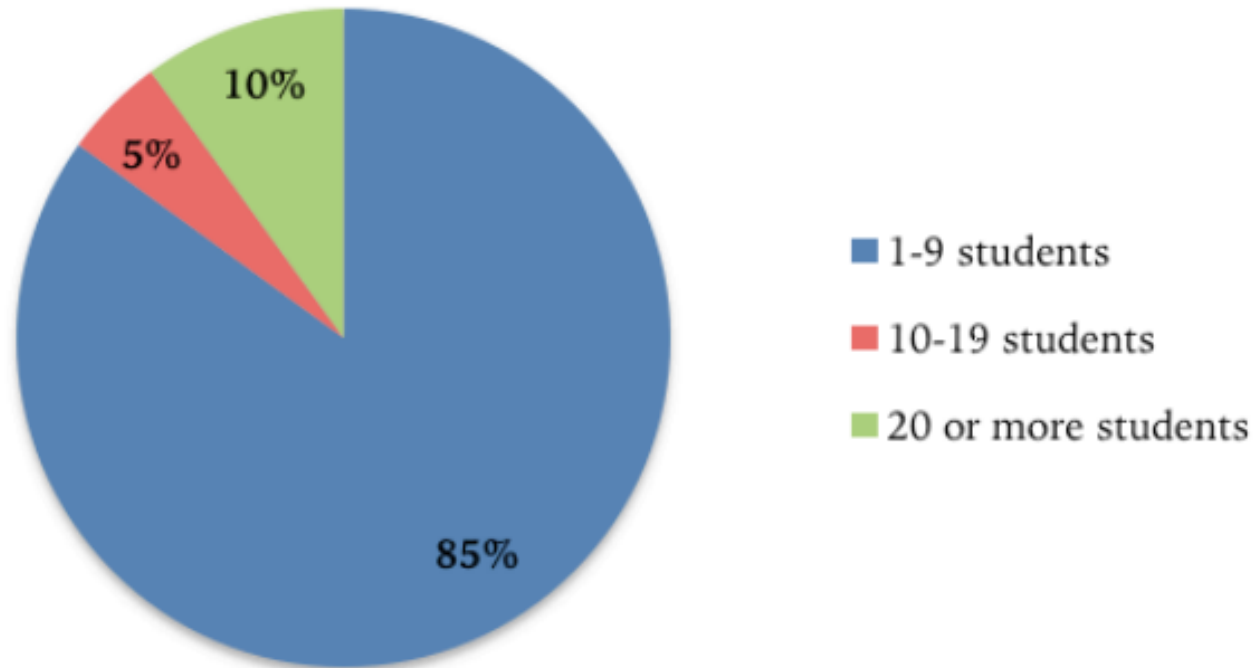

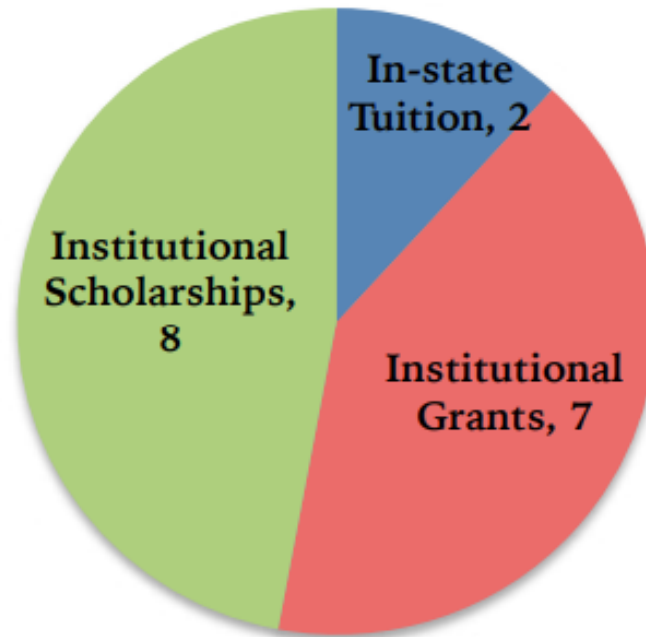
