# **Policy and Research - Projects**

## Developmental Math Demonstration Project

NEBHE's Developmental Math Demonstration Project supports community colleges across the region in implementing the free, online learning tools provided by the Khan Academy, specifically for use in developmental math programs and courses. The project investigates the impact that the use of Khan Academy tools has on student success in developmental math through quantitative and qualitative data collection. The Lumina Foundation funds this project.

### New England State Data Project

NEBHE analyzed existing state-based high school-to-college data initiatives and prepared a six-state action plan for expanding the region's capacity to use data to improve college readiness and success. NEBHE partnered with Hezel Associates of Syracuse, N.Y., to assist in interviewing national experts, selecting and analyzing model states and conducting instate interviews. The Balfour Foundation funded this project.

### Redesigning Student Aid in New England

NEBHE is partnering with three New England states to analyze and provide technical assistance around state student financial aid policies and programs. The Lumina Foundation funds this project.

#### Trends and Indicators

NEBHE provides a clearinghouse of trends in demography, enrollment, financing, success and other education measures. Visitors to NEBHE's website (nebhe.org) now have the ability to sort, filter and create customized analyses of disaggregated data.
