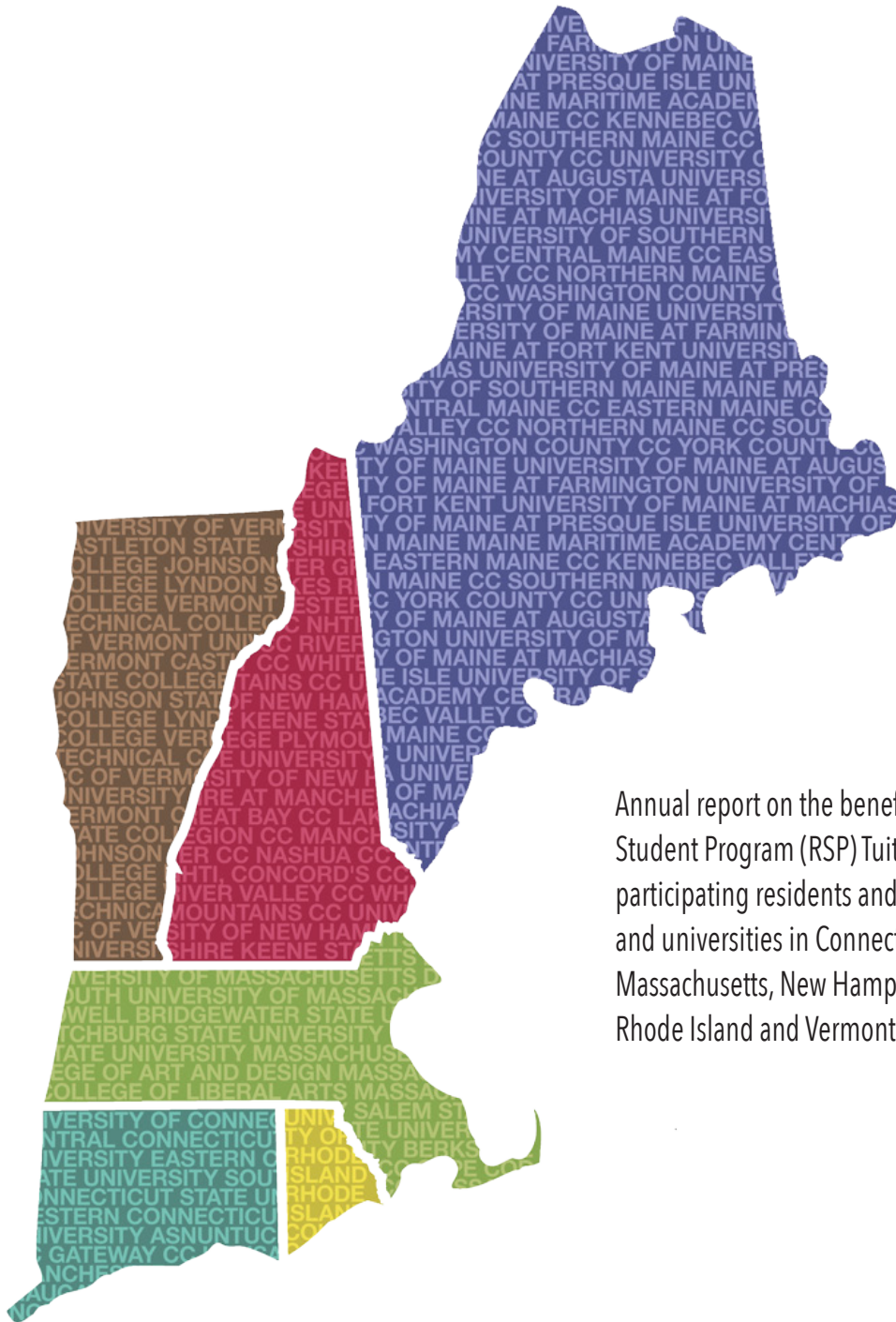

# 2018-19 ANNUAL REPORT of NEBHE’s Tuition Break, the Regional Student Program

## Executive Summary

Academic year 2018-19 marks the 61<sup>st</sup> year of enrollment in the New England Board of Higher Education’s Tuition Break, the Regional Student Program (RSP). NEBHE established the RSP in 1957-58 to fulfill the purposes of the congressionally authorized New England Higher Education Compact – expanding educational opportunities for New England residents and sharing higher education resources. To date, the RSP has provided New England residents with discounts on about 315,000 annual college tuition bills.

About 8,200 New England residents benefited from NEBHE’s RSP Tuition Break in academic year 2018-19 and saved an estimated \$54.2 million on their 2018-19 tuition bills. A full-time student saved an average of \$7,900.

Through the RSP, New England residents are eligible to pay a tuition rate that is significantly lower than the regular out-of-state rate when they leave their state and enroll at public colleges and universities in the six-state region. The out-of-state colleges allow eligibility for a wide array of specialized degree programs, including those that are not offered by students’ home-state public institutions. At some colleges, eligibility extends to students whose home is closer to the out-of-state college than to an in-state college.

NEBHE’s Tuition Break program not only provides much-needed tuition relief to New England students and families but also fosters cost-efficient resource sharing among the six New England states.

The RSP is designed to help eliminate the need to duplicate academic programs offered by public colleges and universities in other New England states and therefore can help the individual New England states and their public higher education institutions avoid billions of dollars in capital and operating expenditures.

The region’s public colleges and universities received an estimated \$98 million in tuition revenue –and approximately \$24 million in fee revenue – from the RSP students enrolled at their campuses in 2018-19. The RSP helps participating campuses in a competitive admissions environment to attract and retain out-of-state New England students, who would have likely attended college elsewhere if the RSP tuition discount were not available.

### Expansion of RSP Eligibility and Program Offerings

About 2,000 undergraduate and graduate degree programs are approved for eligibility under the RSP through an annual peer-review conducted by NEBHE, which engages all the RSP participating institutions. A significant number of RSP degree programs are in specialized or high-demand career areas, such as biomedical engineering, environmental engineering, allied health, pharmacy, energy technology, advanced manufacturing technology and sustainability studies.

### New Flexible Policy Option Approved in 2018 for Four-Year Institutions

A new flexible eligibility policy option for four-year institutions was approved for implementation starting with the 2018 annual review. On that basis, colleges can choose to offer any of their degree and certificate program, based on available capacity, to residents of the other New England states. Eligibility under the Flexible Policy is not dependent on the program being unavailable in a student’s home state. Prior to 2018, only the community colleges had the option to allow eligibility for any program.

## Summary of 2018-19 Regional Student Program (RSP) Data

### 2018-19 RSP Tuition Savings and Revenue

The 2018-19 academic year marks the 61<sup>st</sup> year of enrollment in the New England Board of Higher Education's Regional Student Program (RSP), also known as Tuition Break. The RSP has provided New England students and families significant savings on about 315,000 annual tuition bills since 1957 with estimated total tuition savings in the billions of dollars.

The RSP provided New England residents an estimated total of \$54 million in savings on their 2018-19 tuition bills. The weighted-average savings per full-time student was \$7,900. Meanwhile, the RSP participating institutions received an estimated total of \$98 million in tuition revenue from RSP students in 2018-19.

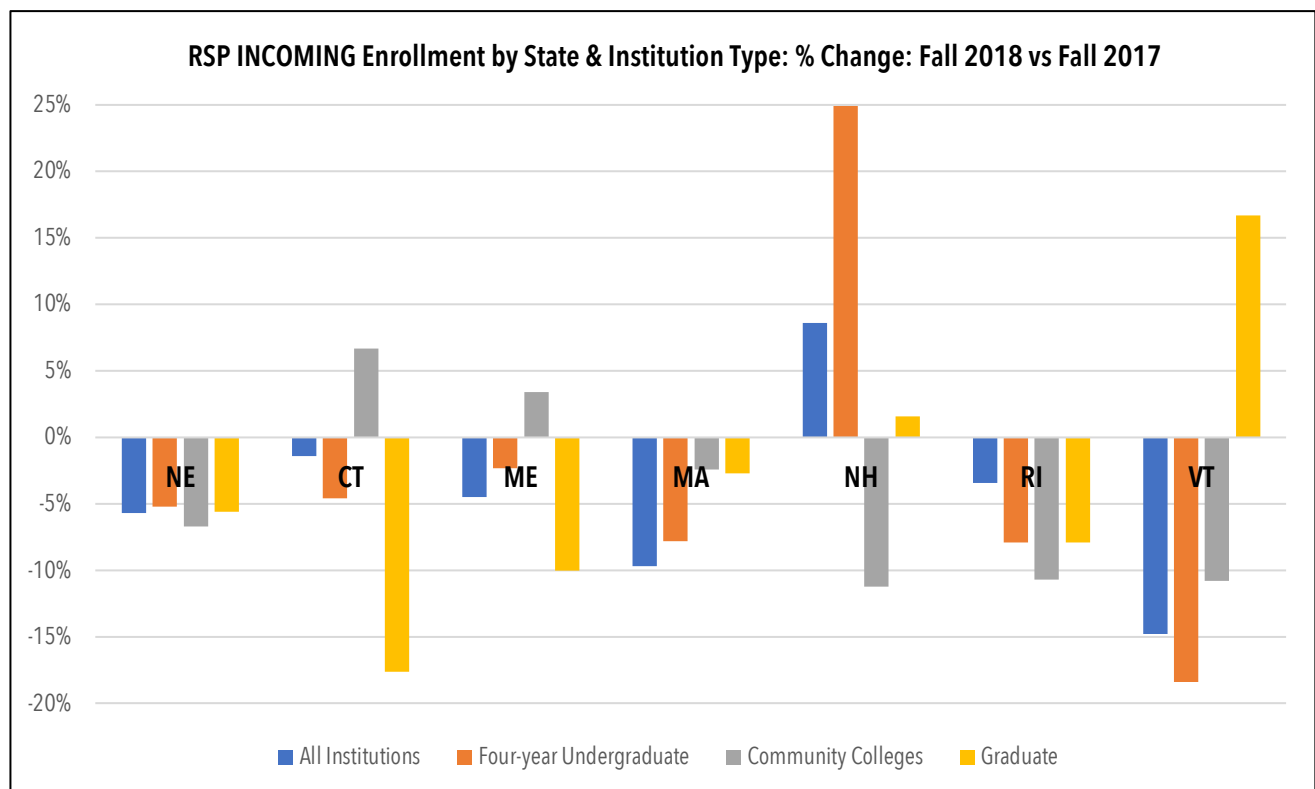
### RSP Enrollment: Fall 2018 vs Fall 2017

A total of 8,159 students were enrolled through the RSP in Fall 2018. By institution type, 60% were enrolled in four-year undergraduate programs, 34% in community college programs, and 6% in graduate programs.

- Total RSP enrollment decreased by 5.7%, following a 3.9% decrease in Fall 2017 and a 0.5% increase in Fall 2016.
- Community college enrollment decreased by 6.7%, following a 8.9% decrease in Fall 2017 and a 5.4% decrease in Fall 2016.
- Four-year undergraduate enrollment decreased by 5.2%, following a 2.1% decrease in Fall 2017 and a 6.8% increase in Fall 2016.
- Graduate enrollment decreased by 5.6%, following an 11.1% increase in Fall 2017 and a 17.6% decrease in Fall 2016.

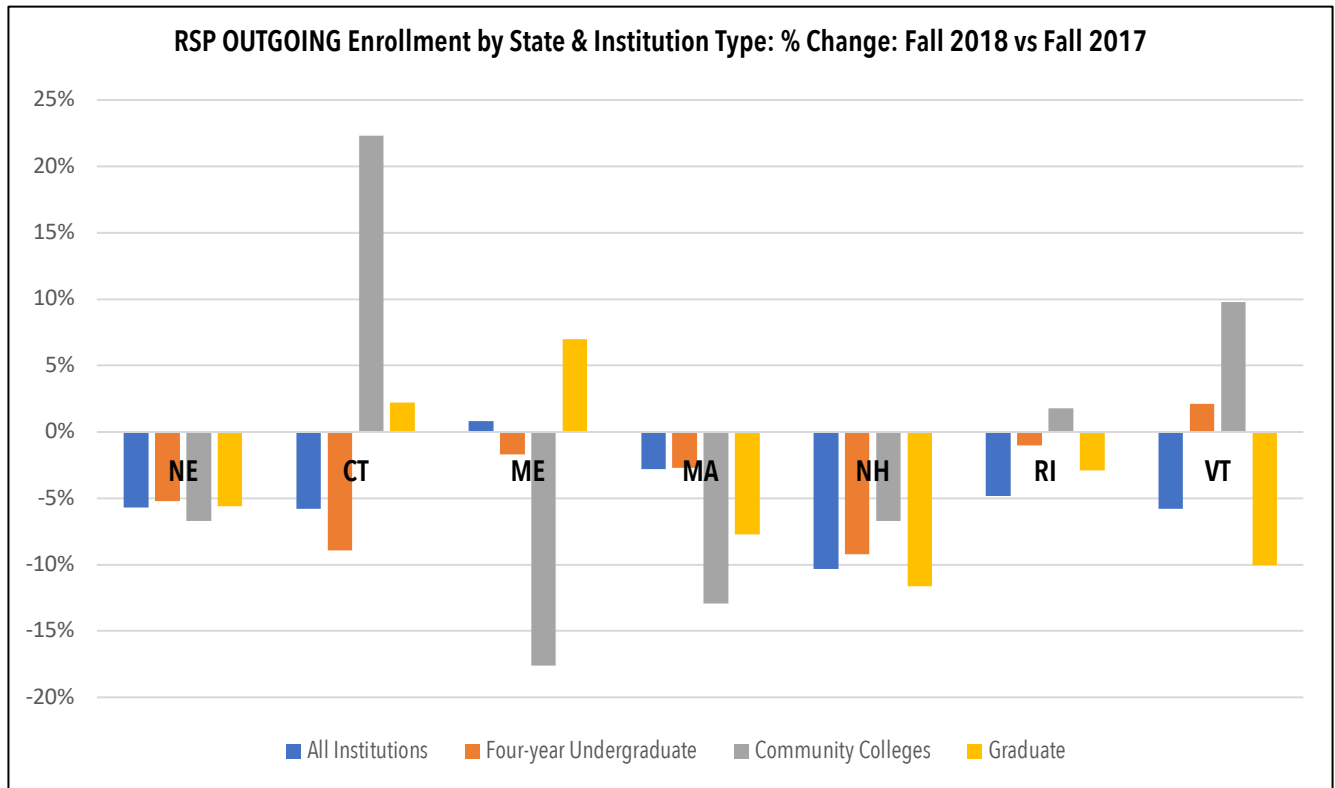
### RSP INCOMING Enrollment

- New Hampshire was the only state where public institutions saw an *overall increase* in RSP enrollment – up 8.6%.
- Four-year undergraduate enrollment increased 24.9% in New Hampshire.
- Community college enrollment increased 6.7% in Connecticut and 3.4% in Maine.
- Graduate enrollment increased 16.7% in Vermont and 1.6% in New Hampshire.



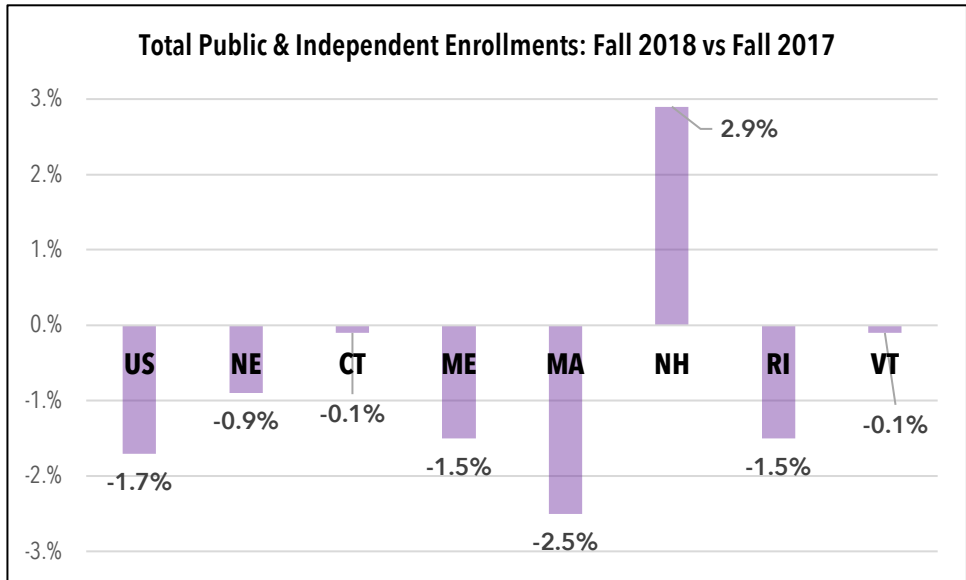
**RSP OUTGOING Enrollment**

- Four-year undergraduate enrollment of Vermont residents increased 2.1%.
- Community college enrollment of Connecticut residents increased 22.3%, Vermont residents, 9.8% and Rhode Island residents, 1.8%.
- Graduate enrollment of Maine residents increased 7.0% and Connecticut residents, 2.2%.



**Data Source**

The New England Board of Higher Education surveyed all of the RSP participating institutions for Fall 2018 enrollment data and student characteristics. NEBHE calculated annual 2018-19 enrollment and tuition savings and revenue data, based on Fall 2018 enrollment data and annual tuition rates.



### Snapshot of Overall Enrollment Trends

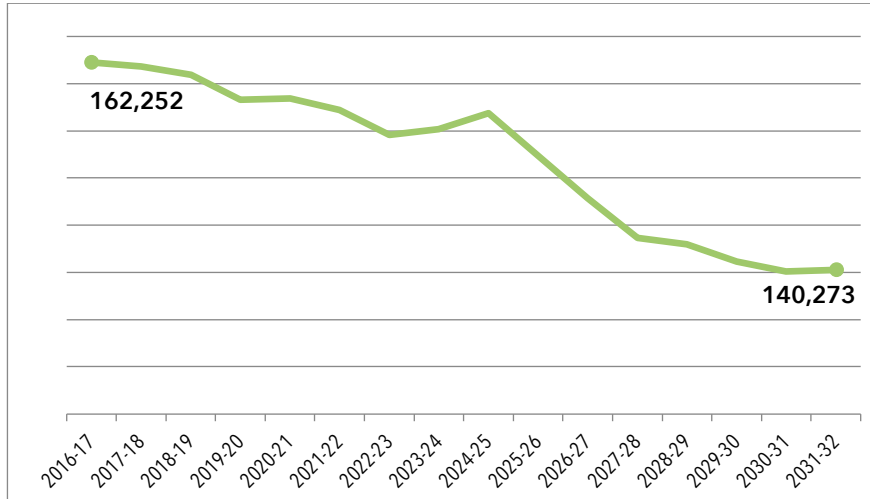
Five of the New England states saw one-year decreases in overall total enrollment (public and independent), according to the National Student Clearinghouse Dec. 2018 report, *Current Term Enrollment Estimates, Fall 2018*. New Hampshire was the only state with an overall increase.

### College Enrollments Challenged by Declining Numbers of High School Graduates

College enrollments are increasingly challenged by declining numbers of high school graduates, especially in New England. The numbers of high school graduates is expected to continue declining through 2032, according to the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education's (WICHE) Dec. 2016 *Knocking at the College Door* report.

### Number of New High School Graduates in New England Projected to Decline 14% by 2032

Overall, the number of new high school graduates in New England is projected to decline by 14% between 2017 and 2032, with Connecticut and New Hampshire predicted to face the steepest declines. The number of New England high school graduates reached its peak in academic year 2009-10 at 172,106.

**Fig. 7. Graduate RSP Enrollment: 2018-19 (6% of total enrollment)**

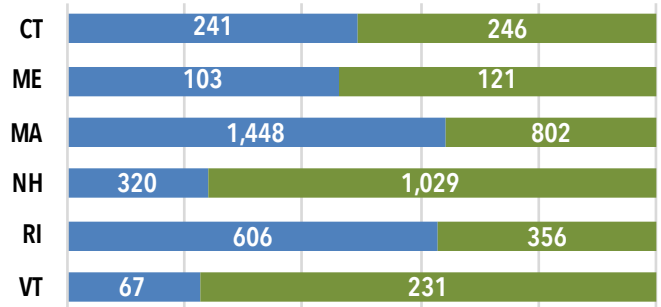

**Fig 8. RSP Migration: 2018-19**

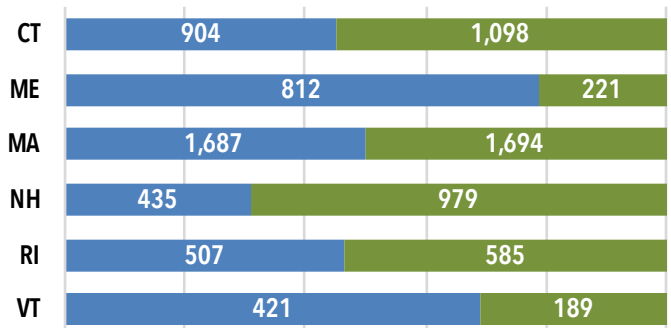

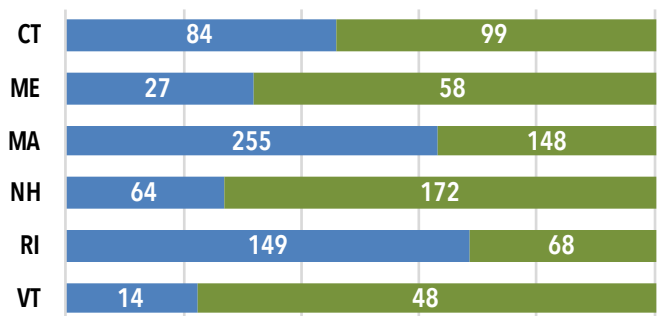
**RSP Enrollment at Community Colleges: 2018-19** ■ IN ■ OUT

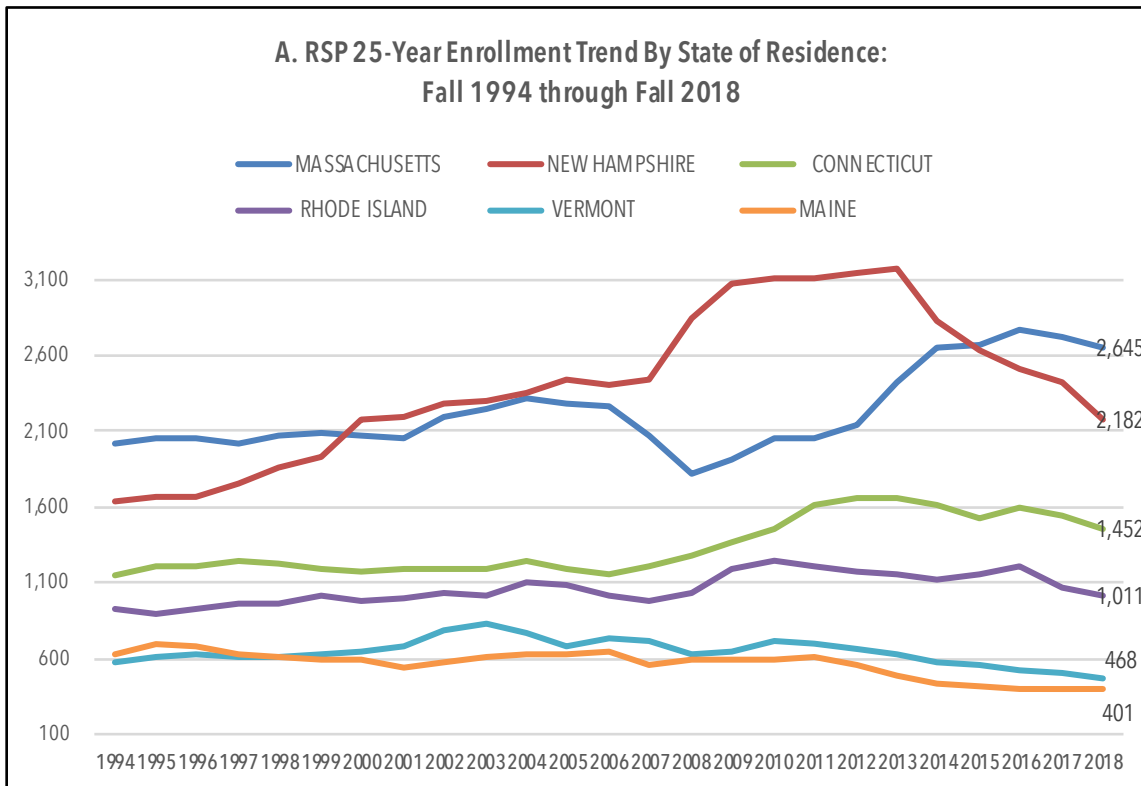

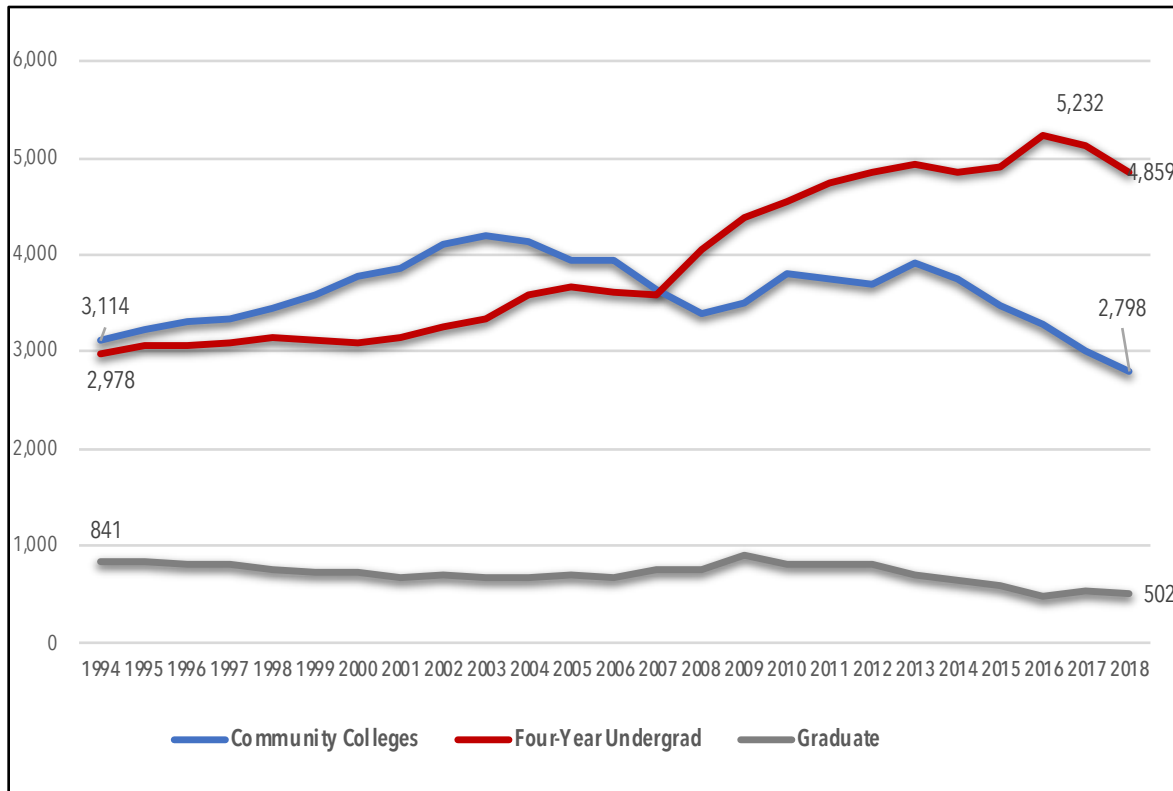
