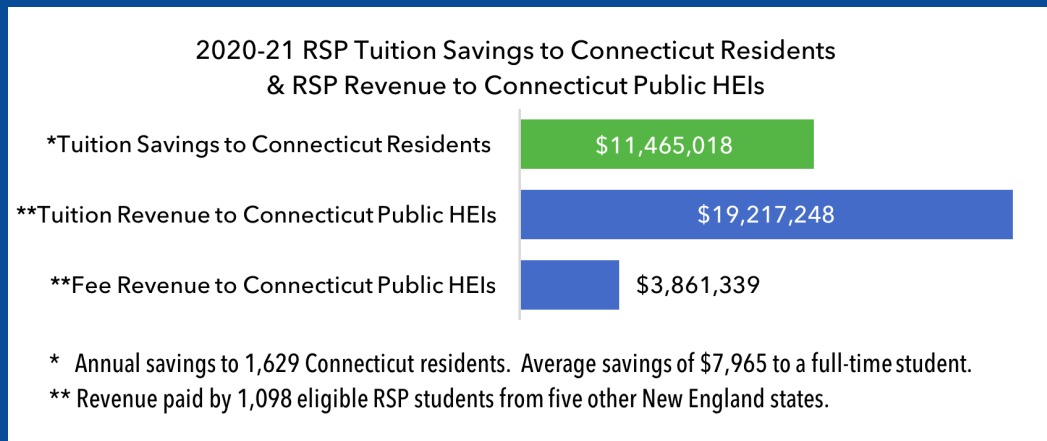


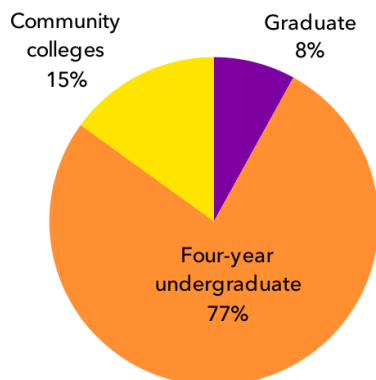
CONNECTICUT: HIGHLIGHTS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE RSP TUITION BREAK, 2020-21

The RSP provides tuition savings to Connecticut residents enrolled in approved degree programs at public campuses in the five other New England states, and provides a reciprocal benefit to eligible New England residents enrolled at Connecticut's public higher education institutions. Connecticut residents are eligible for more than 900 undergraduate and graduate degree programs with the RSP Tuition Break.

NOTES REGARDING DATA:

Tuition savings equals the discount on out-of-state tuition that Connecticut residents receive because of the Regional Student Program (RSP), Tuition Break. Revenue figures represent the tuition paid by incoming RSP students. All tuition revenue and savings figures are estimates based on annual tuition rates and FTE figures for the fall 2020 semester. Average annual tuition savings is based on full-time enrollment.
