New England Board of Higher Education's Tuition Break 2020-21 Annual Report Executive Summary

The 2020-21 academic year was a year like no other as a pandemic caused unprecedented disruptions on college campuses. New England colleges and universities responded with agility as they worked to ensure safe campus operations for students, faculty and staff, while continuing to offer their programs through hybrid, in-classroom and remote formats.

COVID-19 had a significant impact throughout the U.S. Enrollment at higher education institutions (HEIs) declined by 2.5 percent overall, nearly twice the rate of decline reported in fall 2019, according to the National Student Clearinghouse Dec. 2020 report, [Current Term Enrollment Estimates, Fall 2020](#). Freshman enrollment overall decreased an unprecedented 13 percent. Public colleges and universities saw a 4 percent decrease from Fall 2019 enrollment, and community colleges saw a 10 percent decrease.

Tuition Break enrollment increased at 40% of institutions

Although the majority of New England public colleges and universities saw overall enrollment decreases in Fall 2020, 40 percent of them saw increases in the number of students eligible through Tuition Break. Total enrollment through Tuition Break increased about 1 percent at the four-year institutions but decreased nearly 12 percent at the community colleges. (See the Data Summary in this report and Fig. 9.)

A total of 9,142 New England residents benefited from NEBHE's Tuition Break and saved an estimated \$63.1 million on their annual tuition bills in 2020-21. A full-time student saved an average of \$8,265. Through Tuition Break, New England residents are eligible to pay a tuition rate that is significantly lower than the regular out-of-state rate when they enroll in approved programs offered by out-of-state public colleges and universities within the six-state region.

Meanwhile, the region's public colleges and universities received an estimated \$142 million in tuition and fee revenue from the RSP students enrolled at their campuses in 2020-21.

NEBHE established Tuition Break as the New England Regional Student Program (RSP) in 1957-58 to fulfill the purposes of the congressionally authorized New England Higher Education Compact—expanding educational opportunities for New England residents and sharing higher education resources. To date, the RSP has provided New England residents with discounts on more than 333,000 annual college tuition bills with total savings in the billions of dollars.

Key benefits of the RSP Tuition Break are:

- Affords significant savings on out-of-state tuition to eligible residents
- Provides access to wide array of academic programs, many in specialized and high-demand fields
- Helps attract and retain out-of-state New England students at participating campuses
- Fosters resource sharing among the states and reduces the need to duplicate programs offered in nearby states

More than 2,200 program offerings

The participating colleges and universities allow eligibility for a wide array of degree programs, including specialized programs that are not offered by public HEIs in the students' home-state. A significant number of Tuition Break programs are in specialized or high-demand career areas, such as bioengineering, cybersecurity, homeland security, justice studies, environmental engineering, allied health, nursing, pharmacy, energy technology, advanced manufacturing technology, sustainability studies, wildlife ecology and zoology.

NEBHE engages the participating institutions in an annual review to approve programs. During the 2020 annual review, institutions approved a total of more than 2,200 programs that will be [available to eligible students in 2021-22](#).



Three options for eligibility

The Tuition Break [policies](#) provide three options for eligibility. Participating institutions decide how they will allow eligibility.

1. **Specialized Programs** Allows eligibility for any program that is not offered by a home-state public college or university. NEBHE conducts an annual review to determine eligibility in each state. This policy has been in effect since the beginning of the RSP.
About 60% of programs are eligible under Specialized.
2. **Proximity Programs** Allows eligibility for students who live closer to an out-of-state college than an in-state college offering a particular program. This policy has been in effect since the late 1960s as an option for community colleges and since the late 1980s for four-year institutions.
3. **Flexible Programs** Allows institutions to offer one or more of their programs to residents of the five other New England states (regardless of whether the program is offered in the home-state). This policy took effect as an option for participating four-year HEIs in Fall 2019, following approval by the NEBHE board in 2018. The Flexible policy previously applied only to the community colleges, since 1971. About 45 percent of four-year HEIs currently allow [Flexible eligibility](#). About 40% of programs are eligible under Flexible.

This report provides data on Tuition Break enrollment and tuition revenue and savings for the 2020-21 academic year, as well as historical data. NEBHE thanks the campus officials who provided detailed Fall 2020 enrollment information, as well as the campus representatives and administrators who oversee the ongoing participation of their institutions in Tuition Break.

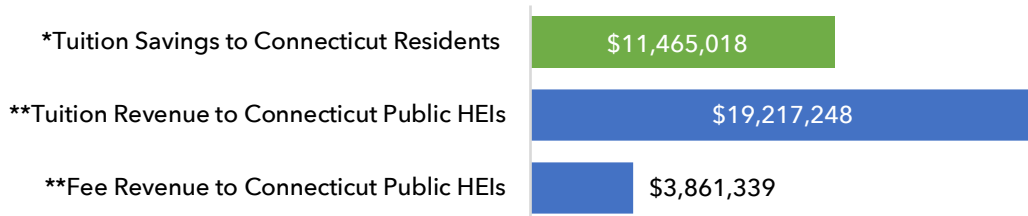

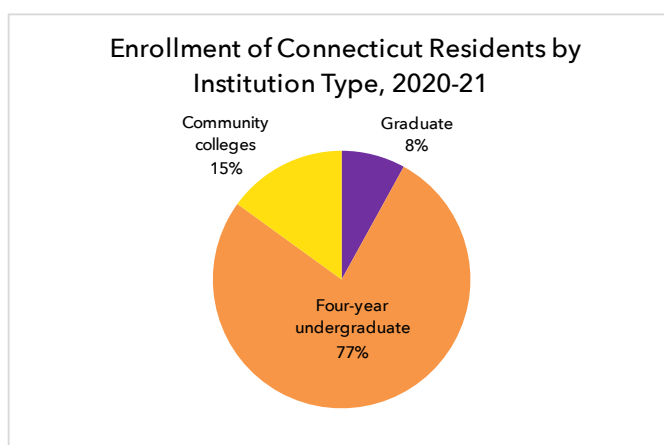
2020-21 RSP Tuition Savings to Connecticut Residents & RSP Revenue to Connecticut Public HEIs

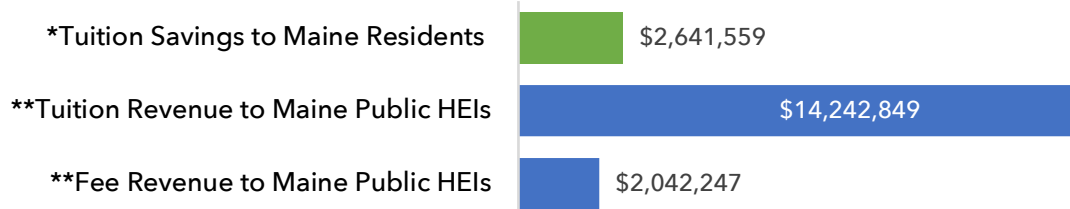

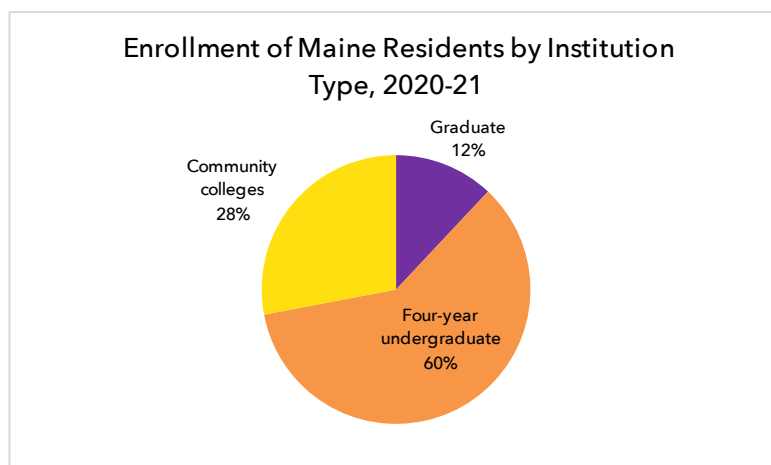
2020-21 RSP Tuition Savings to Maine Residents & RSP Revenue to Maine Public HEIs

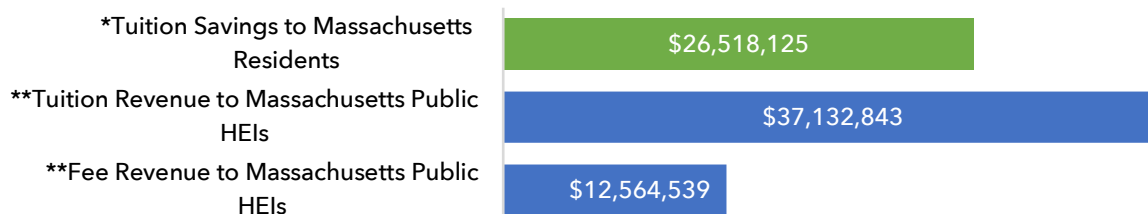

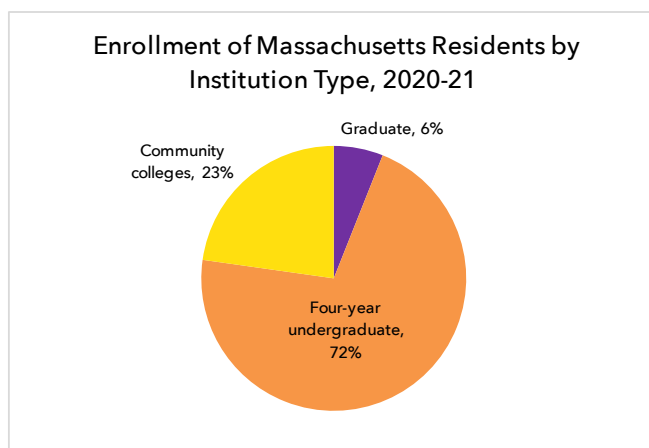
2020-21 RSP Tuition Savings to Massachusetts Residents & RSP Revenue to State's Public HEIs

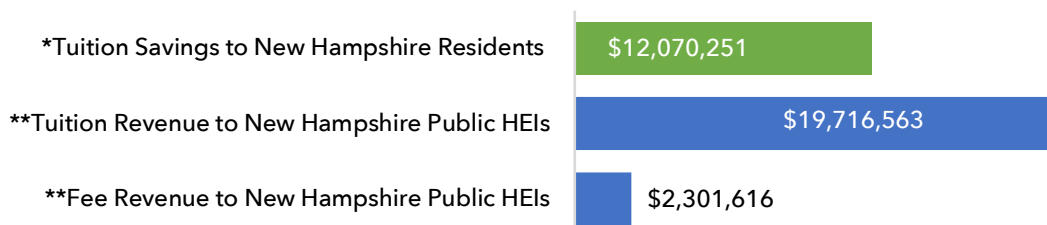

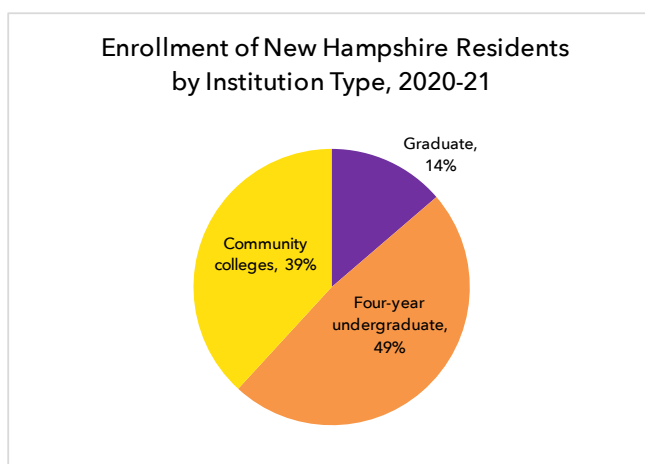
2020-21 RSP Tuition Savings to New Hampshire Residents & RSP Revenue to New Hampshire Public HEIs

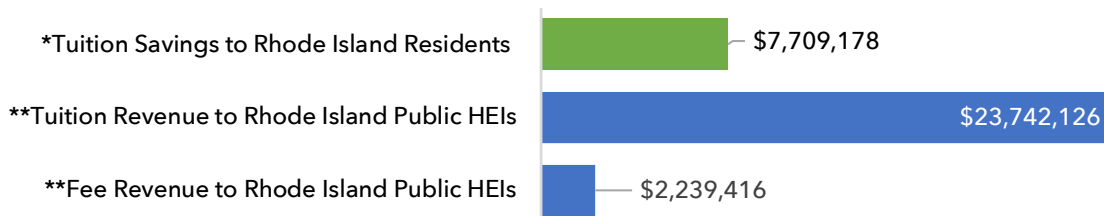

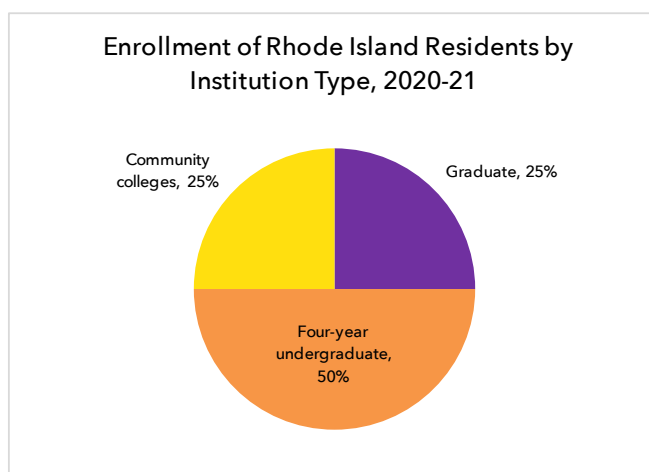
2020-21 RSP Tuition Savings to Rhode Island Residents & RSP Revenue to Rhode Island Public HEIs

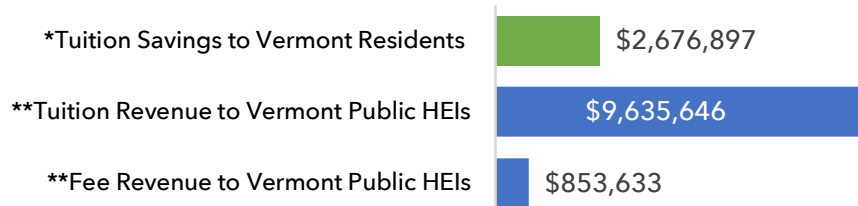

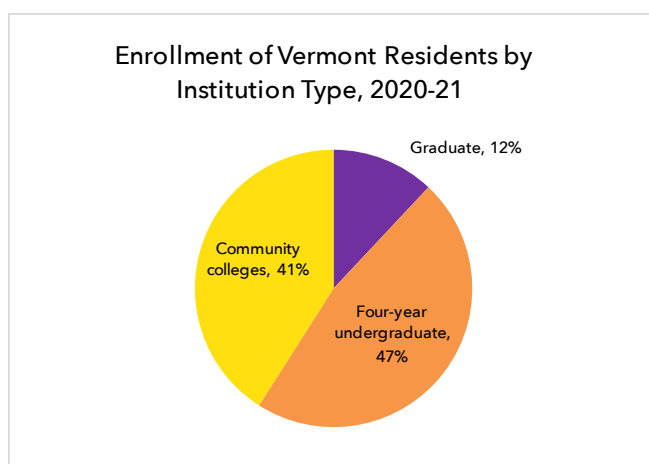
2020-21 RSP Tuition Break Savings to Vermont Residents & Revenue to Vermont Public HEIs

Summary of 2020-21 Data for Regional Student Program (RSP) Tuition Break

RSP Tuition Savings and Revenue

The RSP has provided New England students and families significant savings on more than 333,000 annual tuition bills since the first year of enrollment in 1957 with estimated total tuition savings in the billions of dollars.

The estimated average savings for a full-time student was \$8,265 in 2020-21, the 63rd year of enrollment.

RSP Enrollment: Fall 2020 vs Fall 2019

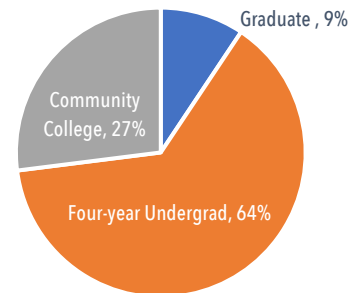
Total enrollment decreased slightly in Fall 2020, after a strong increase in Fall 2019.

Four-year enrollment (undergraduate + graduate) increased slightly in Fall 2020 (+0.8%).

Graduate enrollment increased significantly for the second year in a row.

Community college enrollment decreased, for the sixth year in a row.

Snapshot of Overall Enrollment Trends

Enrollment at higher education institutions (HEIs) declined by 2.5 percent overall nationally, nearly twice the rate of decline reported in fall 2019, according to the National Student Clearinghouse Dec. 2020 report, *Current Term Enrollment Estimates, Fall 2020*. The largest drop was in the public two-year sector (-10.1%). All other sectors had more positive enrollment outcomes than the previous fall, and graduate enrollment had a significant increase (3.6%) across all sectors.

Four of the New England states saw two-year decreases in overall total enrollment (public and independent), with Rhode Island seeing the highest one-year decrease (-6.0%). New Hampshire was the only state with increases over the last four years (attributed in part to Southern New Hampshire University).

The average annual tuition discount for a full-time RSP student was \$8,265. The RSP participating institutions received an estimated total of \$123.7 million in tuition revenue from RSP students.

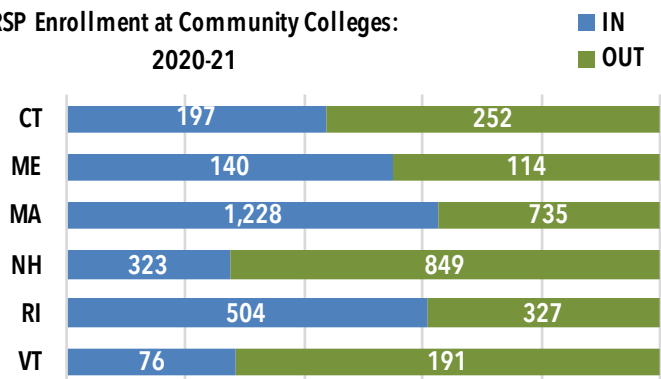
Fig 8. RSP Migration: 2020-21

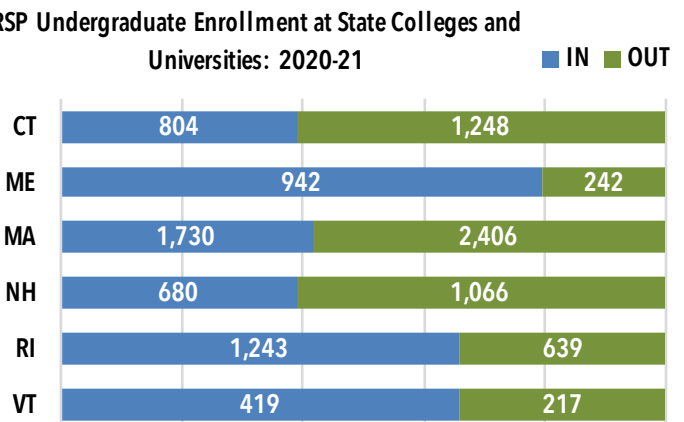

RSP Graduate Enrollment: 2020-21

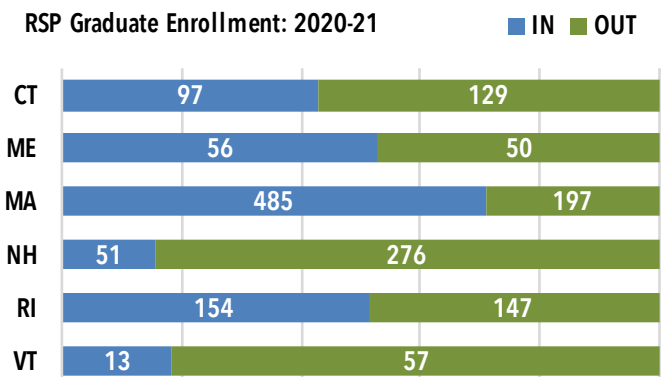


Fig. 9. RSP Enrollment by Institution and State: 2011-12 through 2020-21 (headcount)

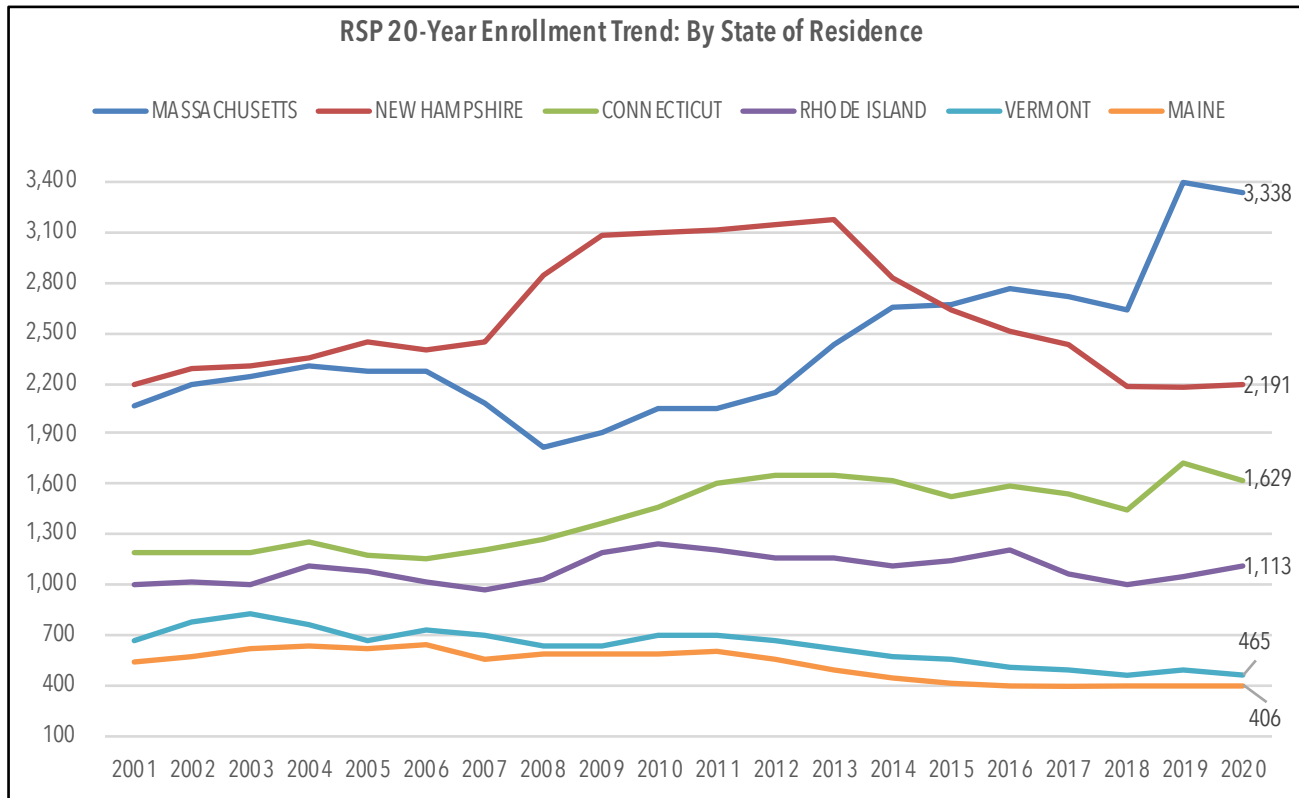

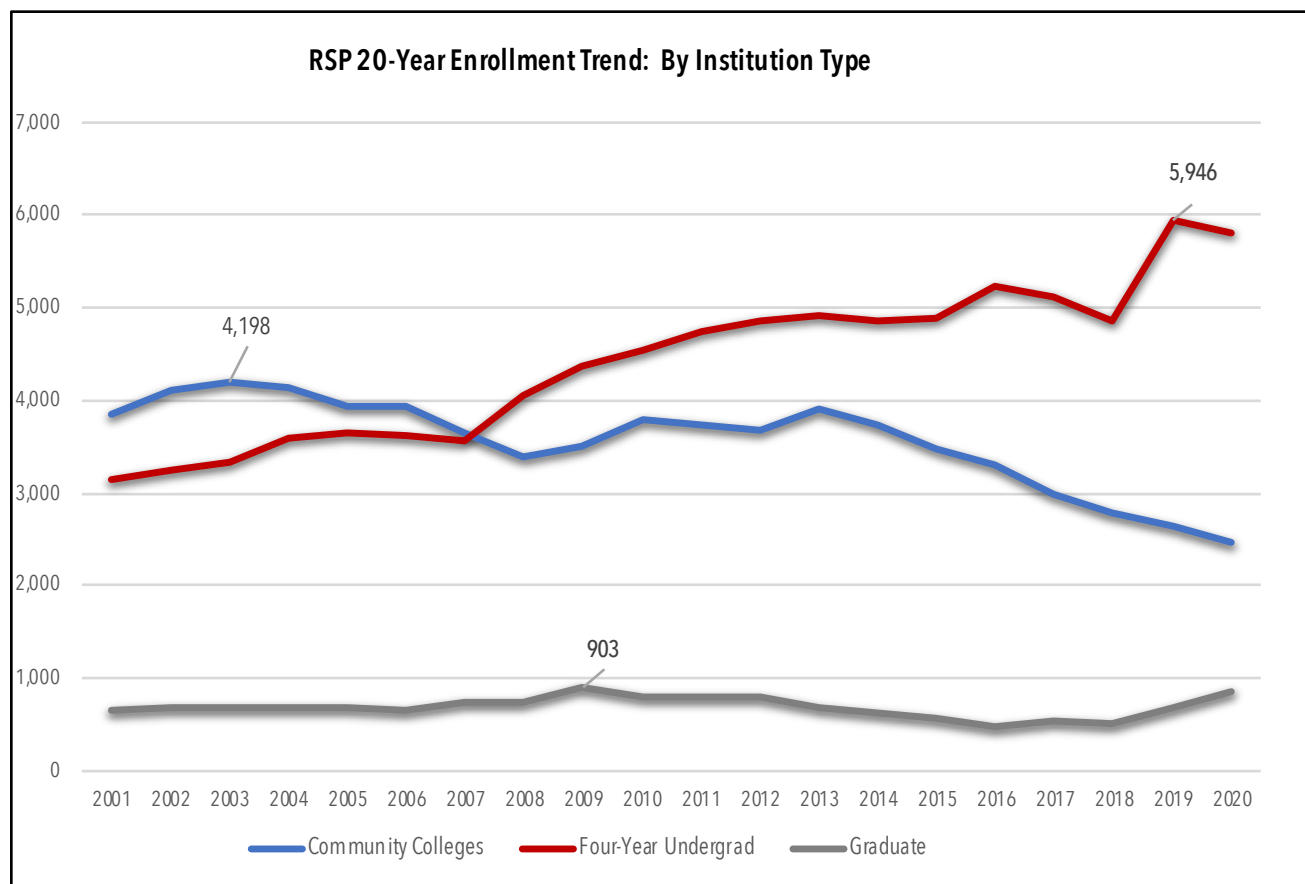
