

## **Tuition Break by the numbers: Fall 2020 enrollment**

### **Total enrollment = 9,142 students**

- Total enrollment through Tuition Break in Fall 2020 decreased about 1% from Fall 2019.
- Community college enrollment decreased overall nearly 12%.
- Four-year undergraduate and graduate enrollment increased about 1%.
- About 40% of institutions saw increases in enrollment.

## **Tuition Break Savings**

Students pay a tuition rate that is usually higher than in-state tuition but is much lower than out-of-state tuition.

Average annual savings is \$8,300.



## **Participating Colleges and Universities**

All community colleges and state colleges and universities in New England (total of 82).

## **All Degree Levels**

Associate, bachelor's, master's, doctoral, as well as certificates and diplomas.



## What makes a program eligible for Tuition Break?

- Programs are voluntarily offered by public colleges and universities that are outside a student's home state – within New England.
- Participating colleges and universities approve program offerings through an Annual Review administered by NEBHE.
- Every September NEBHE publishes a list of programs approved for the following academic year.

## **Proximity Programs**

Programs offered by some colleges to students whose home is closer than to an in-state college



## **Flexible Programs**

Programs offered by some colleges that are designated as approved for residents of any state




