# New England Board of Higher Education's Tuition Break for New England Residents

## New England Regional Student Program

## 2015-16 Annual Report Executive Summary

This academic year, a total of 8,958 New England residents were enrolled under the New England Board of Higher Education's Regional Student Program (RSP) and saved an estimated \$58 million on their 2015-16 tuition bills. Students who were enrolled full time saved an average of \$7,900.

Because of NEBHE and its RSP, New England residents are eligible for a tuition discount when they enroll at out-of-state public colleges and universities in the six-state region and pursue approved degree programs not offered by their home-state public institutions. At some colleges, eligibility also extends to students whose home is closer to an out-of-state college than to an in-state college.

Academic year 2015-16 marks the 58<sup>th</sup> year of enrollment in the RSP, which NEBHE established in 1957-58 to fulfill the purposes of the congressionally authorized New England Higher Education Compact – expanding educational opportunities for New England residents and sharing higher education resources. Since it was established, the RSP has provided New England residents with discounts on 289,000 annual college tuition bills.

NEBHE's Tuition Break program not only provides much-needed tuition relief to New England students and families but also fosters cost-efficient resource-sharing among the six New England states.

The RSP eliminates the need to duplicate academic programs offered by public colleges and universities in other New England states and therefore helps the individual New England states and their public higher education institutions avoid countless billions of dollars in capital and operating expenditures.

The region's public colleges and universities received more than \$69 million in tuition revenue from the RSP students enrolled at their campuses in 2015-16. The RSP helps participating campuses attract and retain out-of-state New England students who would have likely attended college elsewhere if the RSP tuition discount were not available.

## **Expansion of RSP Program Offerings**

More than 850 undergraduate and graduate degree programs have been approved for eligibility under the RSP through an annual peer-review conducted by NEBHE, which engages all the RSP participating institutions. A significant number of RSP degree programs are in specialized or highdemand career areas, such as biomedical engineering, environmental engineering, allied health, pharmacy, energy services technology, advanced manufacturing technology and sustainability studies. The 2015 Annual Review resulted in the approval of 28 additional degree programs:

## Summary of 2015-16 Regional Student Program (RSP) Data

## 2015-16 RSP Tuition Savings and Revenue

The New England Board of Higher Education's Regional Student Program (RSP) Tuition Break provided New England residents an estimated total of \$58 million in savings on their 2015-16 tuition bills.

The weighted-average savings based on full-time enrollment was \$7,900 for all RSP students, \$8,949 for undergraduate RSP students at state colleges and universities, \$7,925 for RSP graduate students, and \$5,593 for RSP community college students.

Meanwhile, the RSP participating institutions received more than \$69 million in tuition revenue from RSP students in 2015-16.

## 2015-16 RSP Enrollment Data

Total RSP enrollment this academic year was a headcount of 8,958, down 3% over last year. Enrollment at the community colleges, (39% of RSP enrollment), decreased 7% from 2014-15 totals. Graduate enrollment decreased by 3%. Undergraduate enrollment at the state colleges and universities basically matched last year's numbers, decreasing by only 6 students (-.1%).

Estimated national enrollment data for Fall 2015 released in December 2015 by the National Student Clearinghouse showed a 2.4% decrease at two-year publics and a .4% increase at four-year publics in headcount enrollment. According to preliminary data gathered by NEBHE, several of the RSP participating colleges and universities with decreases in RSP enrollment also saw decreases in overall enrollment.

## **Incoming enrollment**

Three states saw increases in the number of RSP students attending their public colleges and universities in 2015-16: Connecticut (6%), New Hampshire (4%), and Maine (3%). The other three states saw decreases: Vermont (-11%), Massachusetts (-6%) and Rhode Island (-4%).

## **Outgoing enrollment**

Two states saw modest increases in the number of their residents participating in the RSP in 2015-16: Rhode Island (3%) and Massachusetts (1%). The other four states saw decreases: Connecticut (-6%), New Hampshire (-7%), Maine (-5%) and Vermont (-4%).

Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine and Rhode Island saw the highest percentage of their state's residents enrolled under the RSP at bachelor's degree-granting institutions -72%, 64%, 51% and 47%, respectively.

Meanwhile, Vermont and New Hampshire and saw the highest percentage of their state's residents enrolled under the RSP at community colleges -55% and 52%, respectively.

Enrollment breakdowns by type of institution and state are provided in Figs. 1 through 9. Migration data by degree level for each state is included on the states' individual highlights pages (pages 5-10). Enrollment numbers for individual degree programs are provided in the Appendix.

## **Data Source**

The New England Board of Higher Education surveyed all of the RSP participating institutions for fall 2015 enrollment data and student characteristics. NEBHE calculated annual 2015-16 enrollment and tuition savings and revenue data, based on fall 2015 enrollment data and annual tuition rates.

NEBHE's Regional Student Program (RSP) provided New England residents an estimated total of \$58 million in savings on their 2015-16 tuition bills. 
## Fig. 7. Graduate RSP Enrollment: 2015-16


## Fig 8. RSP Migration: 2015-16


## Fig. 11. RSP Enrollment History: 1958-59 through 2015-16


