

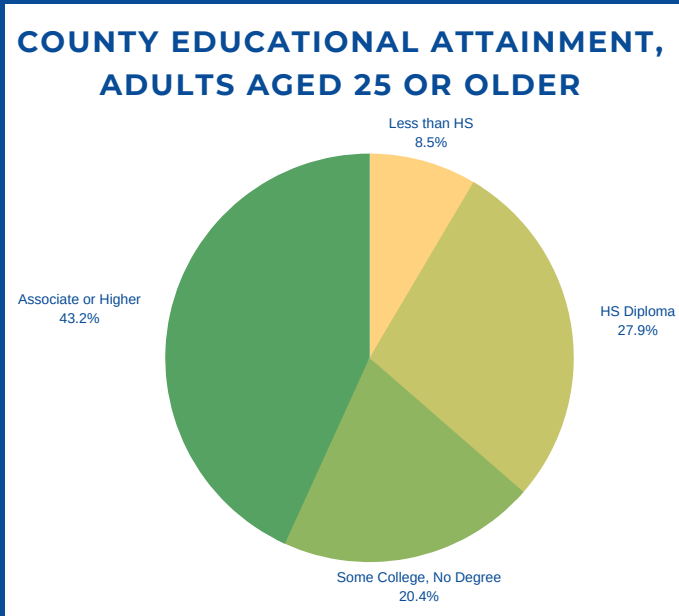

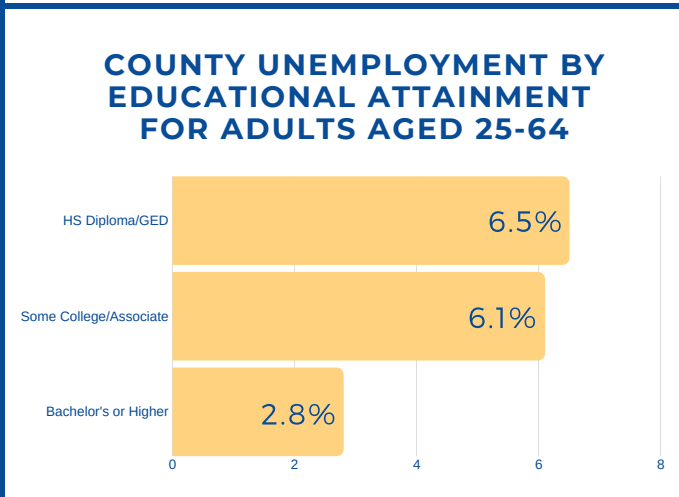

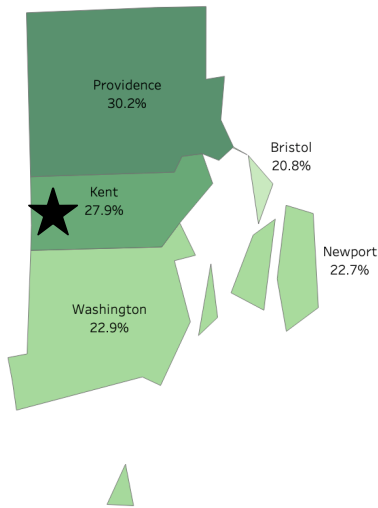

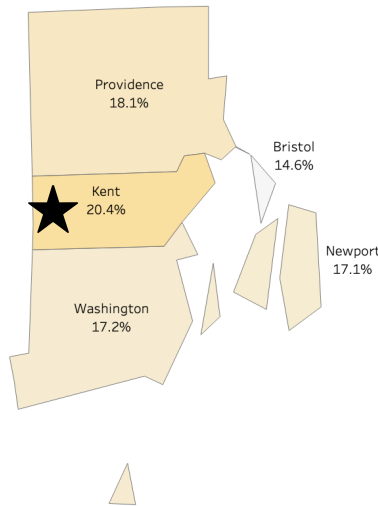

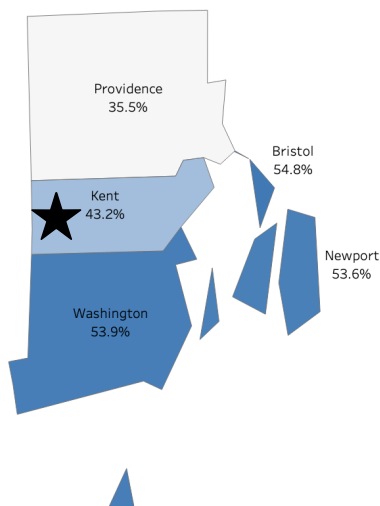
Profile of Adults (Aged 25 or Older) with Some College, No Degree, 2017
