



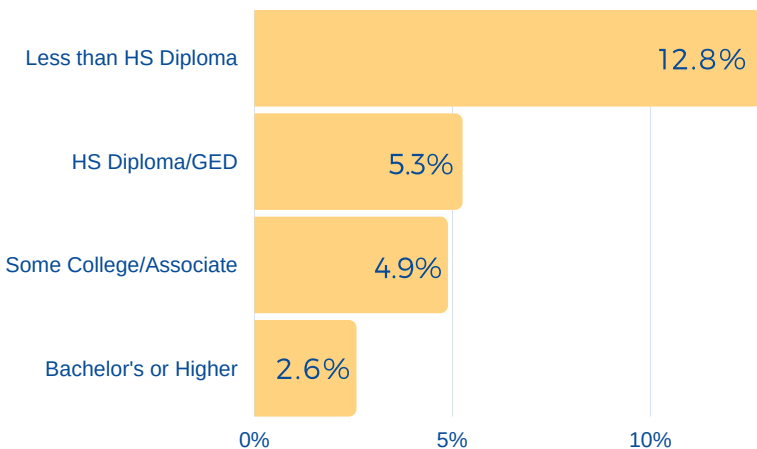

STATE UNEMPLOYMENT BY EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT FOR ADULTS AGED 25-64 (2019)



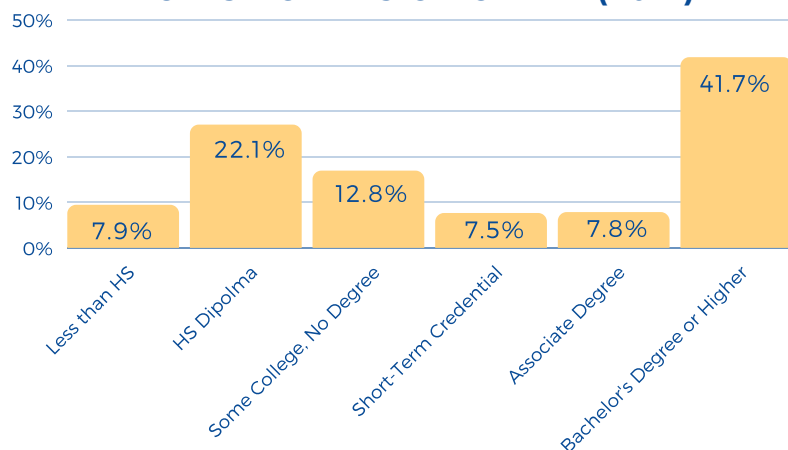

AGE DISTRIBUTION OF COLLEGE STUDENTS IN CONNECTICUT (2019)

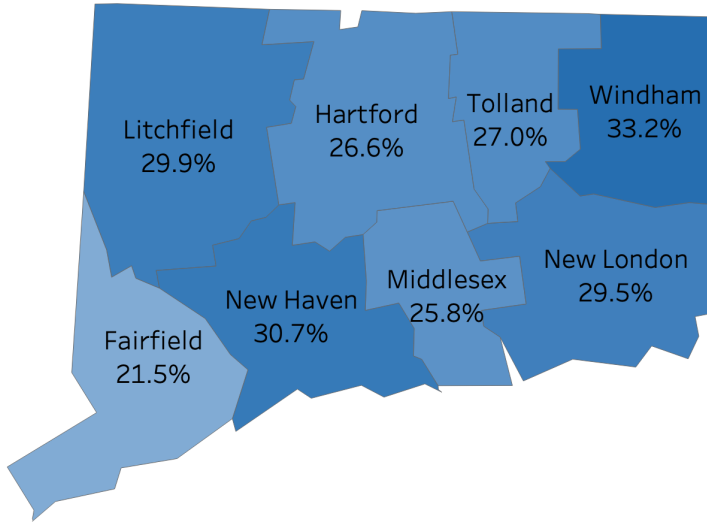

STATE EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, ADULTS AGED 25 OR OLDER (2021)



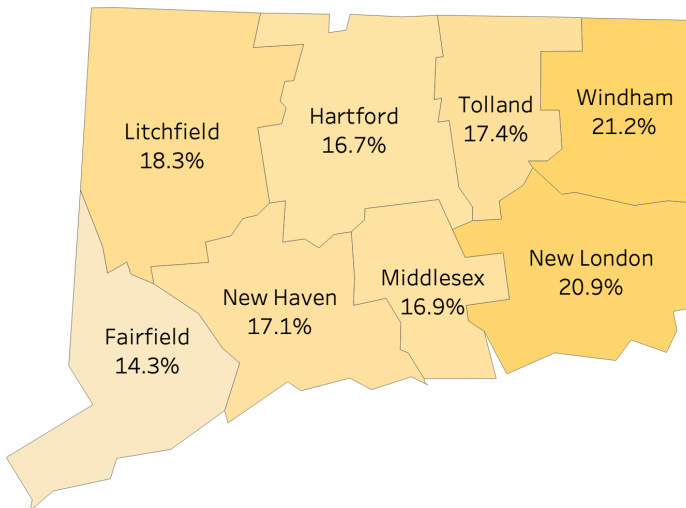

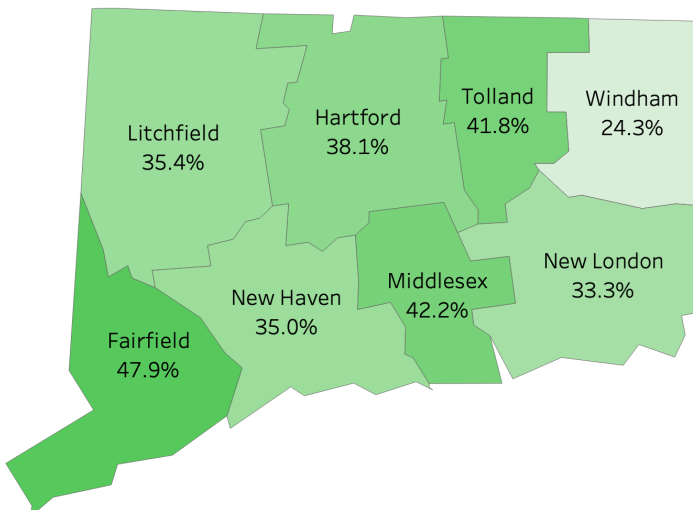

Profile of Adults (Aged 25 or older) with Bachelor's Degree or Higher, 2019

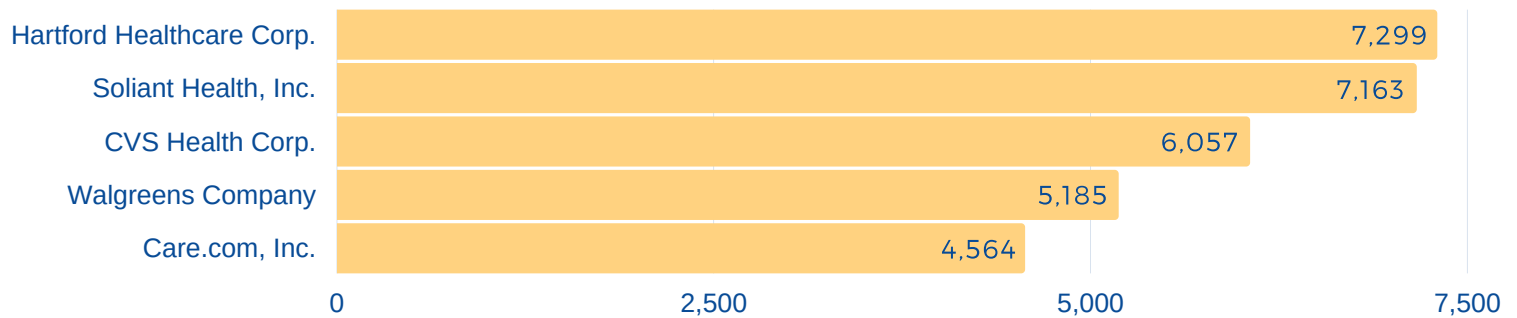

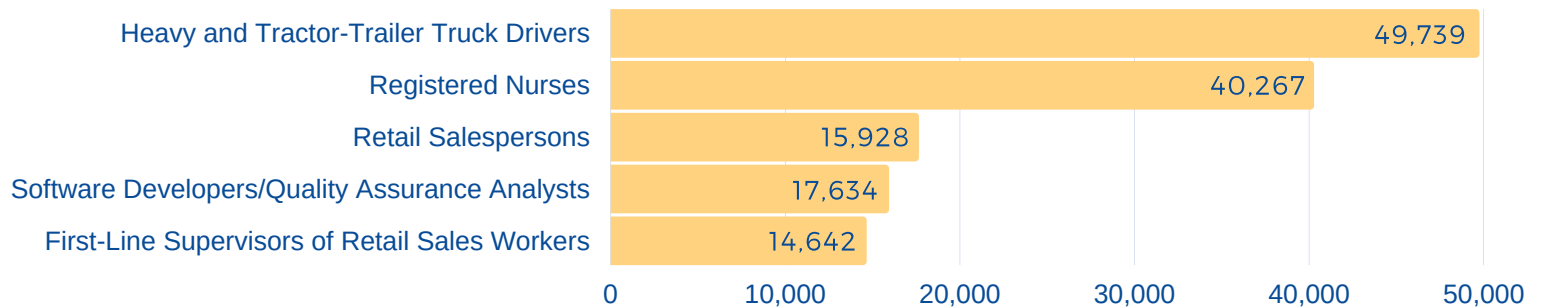

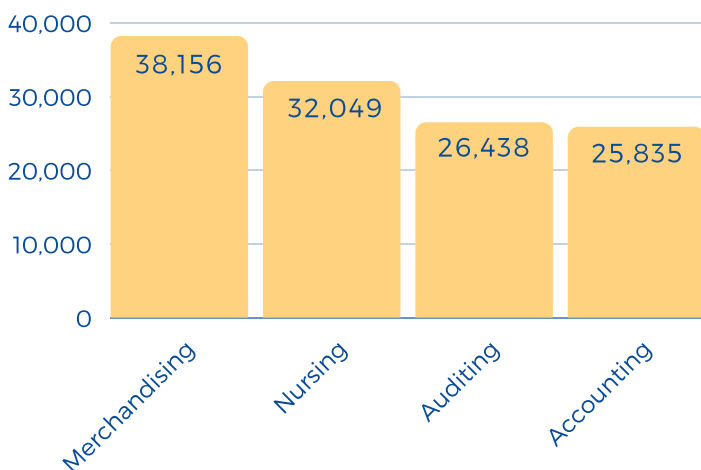
Employers with the Most Job Postings (Apr. 2020–Apr. 2021)
