





### STATE UNEMPLOYMENT BY EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT FOR ADULTS AGED 25-64 (2019)





### AGE DISTRIBUTION OF COLLEGE STUDENTS IN NEW HAMPSHIRE (2017)



### STATE EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, ADULTS AGED 25 OR OLDER (2021)












## Employers with the Most Job Postings (Apr. 2020–Apr. 2021)
