





# AGE DISTRIBUTION OF COLLEGE STUDENTS IN RHODE ISLAND (2019)



## STATE EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, ADULTS AGED 25 OR OLDER (2021)












### Employers with the Most Job Postings (Apr. 2020-Apr. 2021)
